This day Begun with fresh wind from S.W. Steaming N.W. at 30 Pm wind came from N.W. Blowing very hard took in fore Topsail hove to on Starboard Tack at 7 Pm moderate wind wore ship heading N.W. middle part the same latter part clear weather light breeze at 7.30 A m Spoke B.th Mermaid of New Bedford Capt Reed went on board plenty finebacks in sight

Wednesday July 15th

this day Begun with light breeze from N.W. heading N at 7 Pm took in light sails in company with Bark Mermaid middle part the same latter part very clear weather fresh wind from N.E. heading N.W. under all sails Employed in repairing main lower Topsail Bark Mermaid in sight

This day Begun with clear & pleasant weather fresh wind from N.E. heading E.S.E. at 7 o'clock Pm took in light sails and main sail saw plenty finebacks middle part misty weather latter part foggy weather fresh wind from E heading S.E. by S under Topsails

Friday July 17th

This day Begun with breeze from E heading S.E. by S under Topsails at 7 o'clock took in upper Topsails middle part thick and rainy weather latter part clear weather wind from N.E. heading E.S.E. under lower Topsails Employed in breaking bread & Malasse & water

Saturday Bark Petrel July 18th 1891

This day Begun with fresh wind from N.E. heading N.W. by N under lower Topsails middle part the same latter part clear strong wind from N.W. under Topsails heading N.W. Employed in ship's duty

Sunday July 19th

This day Begun with clear weather fresh wind from N.W. under all sails at 7 Pm took in light sails & main sail heading N.W. middle part the same latter part under all sails steering N.W. Employed in sitting up head stays & bend on a new Fore Puff & new main upper Topsail breaking out Cask Pork 4 Bbls

Monday July 20th

This day Begun with cloudy weather fresh wind from W.S.W. under all sails at 7 o'clock Pm took in light sails and main sail heading N.W. middle part the same latter part light fog under Topsails Bend on old fore Topsail Employed in ship's duty

Tuesday July 21st

This day Begun with fresh breeze from W.S.W. under Topsails at 4 Pm Tacked ship heading S.E. middle part the same at 3 o'clock in morning saw B.th Mermaid whaling to the windward at 4 o'clock in morning we reased one B. Whale & got killed by ship & chase him whole the fore noon strong wind & cloudy weather parted Flying Jib bobstay plenty whales in sight all to the windward
