

Wednesday Bark Petrel July 22. 1891

This day Begins with very strong wind from W Still chasing the same whale at 1 Pm the whale got galled by ship again whale went to the windward lowered Starboard & Mast Boat Bark. Mermaid she still to the windward she lowered down the Boats & Struck Boats came on board Shorten Sails Blowing hard at 7 o'clock took in fore Lower Topsail middle part moderate wind. Set Topsails latter part fresh wind at 9 A m reared Two R. Whales on weather beam lowered Starboard & Mast Boat Struck Mast Boat Struck whale run to the windward quick clear weather

Thursday July 23

This day Begins with fresh wind from S.W clear weather Starboard Boat came up to ^{the} Mast & fast to the whale and killed the whale and whale sunk lines parted lost the whale at 3 o'clock Pm Boats got on Board middle part thick fog wind from W latter part the same at 8:30 A m saw one R. whale broke water close the ship going to the windward did not lowered for him thick fog

Friday July 24

This day Begins with strong wind from W heading N.W by N under Topsails at night took in upper Topsails Thick fog middle part light wind & Thick fog latter part the same under Topsails at 12 o'clock reared Two R. Whales light fog fresh breeze

Saturday Bark Petrel July 25. 1891

This day Begins with fresh breeze from W at 30 Pm lowered Starboard & Mast Boat for the same whale Starboard Boat struck the whale & killed him at 5:30 o'clock Pm took whale along side middle part cut the whale in latter part employed in boiling Thick fog



Sunday July 26

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This day Begins with clear weather fresh breeze from S.W heading S by E under Topsails Employed in boiling middle part foggy weather Employed in boiling latter part the same saw a fin back

Monday July 27

This day Begins with strong wind from W.S.W heading N.E Employed in boiling middle part very thick fog latter part the same finished boiling

Tuesday July 28

This day Begins with strong wind from W.S.W heading S.W by W middle part from W Squally latter part the same Employed on Stowed down ail strong wind under Topsails cloudy weather

Wednesday July 29

This day Begins with very strong wind from W.S.W heading S by W at 7 o'clock took in fore sail & fore Lower Topsail middle part the same latter part set fore Topsail strong wind from W heading S by S clear weather
