This day Began with clear weather
Strong from W heading S.W. by S under
Lower Topsails Saw plenty fin backs round
middle part the same latter part very strong
Wind Steering S.W. by S under Lower Topsails

Friday July 31st

This day Began with very strong wind from
S.W. Steering S.W. under lower Topsails at
7 P.m. took in fore Topsail & luffed to the
wind on Starboard Pack heading S.W.
middle part moderate wind Set fore Topsail
latter part wind from S.W. Steering S.W.
under all Topsails Employed in breaking
out Reef

Lat 60° 00 North

Long 33° 32 West

Saturday Aug 1st 1891

This day Began with very clear weather &
light wind from S.E. Steering North at 7 o'clock
took in upper Topsails middle part calm
latter part the same Employed in Ship
duty

Sunday Aug 2nd

This day Began with very light breeze from
S Steering N.W. at 7 o'clock took in light Sails
& fore Topsail mid part luffed to the wind
Heading N.W. by S latter part the same
Employed in repairing old main Topsail
cloudy weather

Monday Bark Petrel August 3rd 1891

This day Began with fog weather fresh wind
from S.W. heading W under lower Topsails
middle part raining & calm latter part
calm & very thick fog Capt Employed in
hauling down Spar for yard
2nd mate M^r Silvia Sick of duty

Tuesday Aug 4th

This day Began with very thick fog &
calm middle part the same latter part
light fog & very light breeze from South
heading W.S.W. under all Sails
Broke out back Reef 3/4

Wednesday Aug 5th

This day Began with light fog & strong
breeze from S.E. heading S.W. by W under all
Sails middle part thick fog & light breeze
took in light Sails latter part fresh wind &
heavy swell under all Sails heading W.S.W.

Lat 57° 55 North

Long 38° 45 West

Thursday Aug 6th

This day Began with strong wind from
S.E. heading W.S.W. under all Sails saw a fin
back middle part calm latter part very light
breeze from E Steering S.W. under all Sails
foggy weather Employed in Ship duty

Friday Aug 7th

This day Began with strong wind from
N.W. by E Steering S.W. foggy weather
middle part light winds from N.W. by W Steering
S.W. latter part wind from S.W. heading S.W. by E
under all Sails Employed in breaking water
clear weather Lat 54° 50 N Long 38° 35 W
