wind from SSE under Topsails Employed
in boiling the men in Starboard Watch
came to Captain for more grub & mate
went in fore-castle & found about 2 lbs
pounds of meat in one of the Berth
middle part finish boiling blowing hard
from westward latter part blowing a
gale wind & rain squalls

Friday Aug 21

This day Began with moderate wind
from NW steering SW under lower Topsails
middle part very light breeze & heavy squalls
latter part the same Employed Stowed
down all clear weather

Saturday Aug 22

This day Began with fresh breeze
from SE steering S.W. by S finish Stowed
down all at night set all sail
middle part very light breeze latter part
the same clear & pleasant weather one
sail in sight
