This day Begins with clear weather
Light breeze from Eastward Steering
S.W. by W under all Sails at Sundown
took in light & Topsails one Sail in
light goin Westward middle part the
Same latter part under all Sails Steering
S.W. by W Employed in Ships duty

Tuesday September 1st 1891

This day Begins with very light breeze
from S.E. Steering S.W. by S at 2 o'clock
Saw raised a School of Black fish Covered
Starboard & West Boat West Boat got Two
Black fish at night Shorten Sails
luffed to the wind heading N.W.
middle part the Same latter part
under all Sails Steering S.W. by S
Employed in boiling Black fish
Three Sails in light goin Westward

Wed Sept 2nd

This day Begins with clear & pleas-
ant weather very light breeze from
S.E. Steering S.W. by S under all Sails
at night Shorten Sails middle part the
Same latter part under all Sails fine weather
Employed in repairing Lower main Topsails
Saw one Steamer goin Westward

Thursday Sept 3rd

This day Begins with very clear weather from
Wind from S.E. heading S.W. at night Shorten
Sails middle part light breeze latter part fresh
breeze Bnd on all main lower Topsails upper Topsails

Friday Back Pelrel September 4th 1891

This day Begins with clear weather light breeze
from S.E. heading S.W. by S under all Sails at
night took in light Sails & Main Sail
middle part very light breeze latter part the
Same Employed in basking Ship out Side

Saturday Sept 5th

This day Begins with wind very light from W
under all Sails at night took in main Sail &
light Sails middle part calm latter part the
Same Employed in Ships duty

Sunday Sept 6th

This day Begins with light breeze from W
steering S.E. by S at night Shorten Sails and
luffed to the wind on Starboard Pack heads
S.W. by S middle part the Same latter part under
Ship heading E by N Wind from North under
all Sails Employed in washing Whale Bone

Monday Sept 7th

This day Begins with clear weather light
breeze from North at night Packed Ship heading
N.W. by W took light Sails middle part very
light breeze latter part the Same Employed
in bundling up whale Bone
