This day Begine with very light breeze from South at 4 o'clock came in sight of Break water in St. Nicholas middle part Employed in making a Ship fast Latter part the same at 11 o'clock a m men refuse to work & they say that they want to see Counsel & at 12 o'clock Capt Reed & Counsel came on board & the men talk with Counsel they were willing to go to work until Monday Received on board 50 pounds of meat

Friday Sept 25

This day Begine with cloudy weather Employed in breaking out oil middle part pleasant Latter part employed in breaking out oil Received on board 50 lbs meat & 3 bags of Potatoes Custom House officer came on board & took all the Packages on Shore

Saturday Sept 26

This day Begine with pleasant weather finish Breaking out oil 22 Cask continue 4680 Galons & put the same on board Barquentine Mases B. Power & 5 Bundle of Whale Bone continue 550 Pounds for New Bedford middle part pleasant Latter part the same

Sunday Sept 27

This day Begine with pleasant weather Sends men on Shore on run Mr. Silva Shore with out leaves

This day Begine with rainy weather the men forward & Boatstewards refuse duty & Counsel came on board & took men on Shore Mr. Silva Still on Shore Capt Reed Sends Jose da Costa on board has Cook

Tuesday Sept 29

fine & pleasant Employed in Stowed down Cask for water Capt Reed Sends 5 men on board to work Manuel Mabe Jose Gordino Manuel Povares Manuel da Silva & Antonio Pedro Shipped one Barrel of Black fish oil on board Mases B. Power for New Bedford

Wednesday Sept 30

This day Begine with fine weather Employed in Stowed Cask for water

Thursday Sept Oct 1

pleasant weather Cooper Employed in Lifting up Shocks Rice on board 300 Galons of Water from the water Boat Mr. Silva came on board to his duty again

Friday Sept Oct 2

This day Begine with pleasant weather Received on board 2945 Galons of water from the water Boat fore mast hands & Boatstewards are clear from the Ship with Capt & Counsel
