Sold one Purce of Malasses to Schooner Baltic
Employed in painting a Ship out Side

Wednesday Oct 7th

& 8 Sacks of Sweet potatoes Employed in
Painting a Ship out Side

Thursday Bark Petrel Oct 8 1891

& Joaquim Morato Shipped Alexander McLeod
as Boatstewer

Painting Ship in Side received on board one Barrel
Sugar Shipped one man Manuel Viera & received
2 Lamp on board
