This day Bazine with pleasant weather fresh wind at 6 A.M. Began to get ready for Sea at 11 o'clock got clear Set all Sails Steering South Custom House officer bring all the Tobacco on board middle part passed Island of St. Mary Latter part clear weather Employed in Ship duty

Thursday Oct 15th

This day Bazine with clear weather fresh from N.W. Steering S by W under all Sails middle part light winds from N.E. under all Sails Latter part the same Employed in Ship duty

Friday Oct 16th

Bazine with clear & pleasant weather light wind from N.E. under all Sails Steering S by W under all Sails Employed in Ship duty middle part fresh wind Latter part the same

Saturday Oct 17th

This day Bazine with squally weather strong wind from N.E. Steering S by W under all Sails Saw one Sail going Westward

Sunday October 18th 1891

This day Bazine with strong wind from N.E. Steering S by W under all Sails middle part squally Latter part light winds Employed in repairing fore & stay sail

Monday Oct 19th

This day Bazine with fresh wind from N.E. Steering S by W under all Sails middle part light wind & squalls Steering S by W Latter part the same Employed in Ship duty Brought out back Reef 3/4 & back Tack & Bk

Tuesday Oct 20th

This day Bazine with strong wind from N.E. under all Sails Saw school of Black fish Two Sails in sight middle part clear Latter part squally Employed in Ship duty

Wednesday Oct 21st

This day Bazine with squally weather light winds from N.E. Steering S by W at 5 o'clock P.M. Signaled a Belgian Bark going Southward middle part very light breeze Steering S by W under all Sails Latter part the same at 8:30 A.M. raised a School of small whales found Starboard Mast & Bow Boat Masts lowered in Starboard Boat & West Boat Struck one whale
