This day Breeze with rain storm
fresh wind from N steering South
one sail in sight gain Eastward
middle part cloudy latter part rain
squalls & thick weather steering South

Monday Nov 30th

This day Breeze with strong wind from
N.W. steering South under Popsails
at night took in Popsail & Camsees
Break out back Broad & back Coal
middle part moderate wind luffed to
on Starboard tack latter the same
steering S by E under all sails
Break out back Port 4 3/4

Lat 35° 50 South
Long 25° 16 West

Tuesday Dec 1st 1891

This day Breeze with rain squalls
fresh breeze from N.W. steering N by E
at night took in upper Popsails &
Gallantsails Saw a few finbacks
middle part calm latter part fresh breeze
steering S.E. under all sails
employed in ship duty

Wednesday Dec 2nd

This day Breeze with very light
breeze from E heading South at night
shorten sails Break out back Port &
Bend on New main sail middle part
very light breeze latter part fresh wind
steering S.E. under all sails wind from N.E

Thursday Bark Petrel December 3rd 1891

This day Breeze with very clear weather
fresh wind from N.E steering South at night
shorten sails Bend on fore lower upper
Popsails middle the same latter part thick
fog strong wind from N.E under all
Popsails heading East

Friday Dec 4th

This day Breeze with strong wind from
N.E at night took upper Popsails heading
East Saw a few backs middle part moderate
breeze latter part strong wind employed in
breaking out Sugar & Beans

Lat 36° 25 South
Long 22° 45 West

Saturday Dec 5th

This day Breeze with strong winds
from N.E under lower Popsails & fore-
sails at night took in fore sail
heading N.E Saw plenty whale feed
middle part strong wind took in fore Popsail
latter part moderate wind under all Popsails
plenty finback in sight

Sunday Dec 6th

This day Breeze with fresh wind from
N.W. steering N.E under Popsails Saw
plenty finback & whale feed middle part very
clear weather latter part the same employed
in breaking out Flour
