

Tuesday P.M. Petrel December 15th 1891

This day Begins with Squally weather Wind from West at 1 o'clock P.M. Came right off Town of Tristan one Boat came off to the Ship Treading Capt Reed Buy 2 Sheeps 3 Geeses & some fish from them at night Shorten Sails Stood to the Westward middle part clear weather Latter part the same Steering E by S Tristan Island in Sight.

Wednesday Dec 16th

This day Begins with very fine weather fresh backing Employed in Ships duty middle part fine weather Latter part Stowed down ail very light breeze from Eastward under all Sails

Thursday Dec 17th

This day Begins with very light breeze from Eastward under all Sails heading S by E fresh Stowed down ail 1300 Gallons middle part Calm Latter part fresh breeze from E heading S by E Employed in Ships duty

Friday Dec 18th

Begins with Strong wind from N.E. Steering S by E under all Sails middle part Squally weather Took in light Sails Latter part Strong Wind under Lower Topsails Steering E.S.E. cloudy weather

Saturday P.M. Petrel December 19th 1891

This day Begins with Strong Wind from N.E. Steering E.S.E. under Lower Topsails Cloudy weather middle part Squally Latter part rain Strong Wind from N.E. under Lower main Topsail

Sunday Dec 20th

This day Begins with rainy weather Strong Wind from N.E. Steering E.S.E. under Lower Topsails middle part Calm Latter part raining & light wind from Eastward Sets Ballant Sails

Monday Dec 21st

This day Begins with rainy weather Strong Wind from N.W. Steering E.S.E. at night took in main Ballant Sails & fore Topsail middle part the same Latter part raining hard & Strong Wind from North Steering E.S.E. under Topsails

Tuesday Dec 22nd

This day Begins with Strong wind from North Steering E.S.E. at night Shorten Sails all but main Lower Topsail luffed to the wind on Port Pack heading E.S.E. rainy weather middle part clear weather Latter part light breeze from N under all Sails Employed in Ships duty
