from N.E under all Sails middle part
squally weather Latter part strong
Wind from East heading S.E. under
all Topsails Employed in breaking
out water cloudy weather

Saturday Jan 9th

This day Breeze with cloudy
weather strong wind from East
heading S.E. at 7 o'clock P.M. took in
upper Topsails middle part Wind came
from N.W. Steering S.E. by S at 8
o'clock in morning luffed to the
Wind on Port Tack Bleeding very hard
took in Fore sail & Fore Topsail Goose
Wing main Topsail Latter part heavy
Gale from N.W. put out two oil Barge

Sunday Jan 10th

This day Breeze with heavy Gale from
N.W. under Goose Wing main Topsail
at 6 o'clock P.M. shipped a Big Sea Canoe
Balustrade on Starboard Side & Fore Stay sail
middle part moderate Wind Set Topsails
Latter part Steering S.E. by S Strong Wind

Monday Breeze Petal January 11th 1892

This day Breeze with Strong Wind from
N.W. Steering S.E. by S Set main Gallant sail
Drizzling weather middle part light Wind
Latter part the same Employed in furl fore stay
Sail

Tuesday Jan 12th

This day Breeze with very light breeze from
N.W. Steering S.E. thick fog middle part took
in main Gallant sail & fore Topsail
Latter part fresh breeze Steering S.E. under

Long 46° 44' East

Wednesday Jan 13th

This day Breeze with foggy weather fresh wind
from West Steering S.E. at 7 o'clock P.M. took
in main Topsails middle part clear weather
light breeze Latter part fresh wind Steering S.E.
Employed in breaking out for Pick & Stowed
4 barrels of Salt water

Lat 38° 04' South
Long 39° 03' East

Thursday Jan 14th

This day Breeze with clear weather fresh
Breeze from N.W. Steering S.E. at 7 o'clock
P.M. took in Gallant sails Courses luffed
to the wind on Port Tack hall Back main
Yard Saw plenty finbacks middle part
very light breeze clear Latter part thick fog
Wind from N heading N.W. under lower
Topsails Barometer 29.2 not
