This day Began with fresh breeze from N.W. Steering S by E under Topsails at 5.30 P.M. Sight Hog Island. Wore Ship heading N. took in main Toppail & jib middle part wore Ship again to the Southward. Latter part Calm Hog Island & apostles Island in sight clear weather

Sunday Jan 24<sup>th</sup>

This day Began with fresh breeze from N.E. Steering W.S.W. under all Sails at 7 o'clock P.M. Shorten Sails middle part luffed to on Starboard Tack. N.W. took in fore Toppails. Latter part thick fog. Blowing hard from N.E. under Lower main Toppail

Monday Jan 25<sup>th</sup>

This day Began with clear weather. Blowing hard from N.W. heading W by S under Lower main Toppail middle part the same. Gase wing main Toppail. Latter part Squally. Employed in Ship's duty.

Tuesday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>

This day Began with moderate wind from N.W. heading W.S.W. under Lower Toppail middle part Steering South. Latter part Raised Hog Island on Leeward & Steering for the Island & came about 12 miles from the Island then Stem East passed apostles Island then holl the Northward fresh wind from N.W.

Wed Bark Petrel January 27<sup>th</sup> 1892

This day Began with strong breeze from N.W. heading N.E. under Lower Toppails at night. Shorten Sails middle part rain squalls & strong wind. Wore Ship heading W.S.W. Latter part fresh Gale wind from N.W. Wore Ship heading N.E. gase wing main Toppail

Thursday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>

This day Began with Gale wind from N.W. heading N.E. under Lower main Toppail middle part moderate. Set fore Toppail wore Ship heading W.S.W. Latter part a heavy squall. N.W. took in fore Toppail

Friday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>

This day Began with heavy Gale wind from W heading N under gase wing main Toppail. Two oil Bags on Board middle part moderate Wind & Clear. Latter part the same. Set fore Toppail Wore Ship heading S by W

Saturday Jan 30<sup>th</sup>

This day Began with strong Wind from N.W. heading N under Lower Toppails. Saw plenty finbacks middle part thick fog & very light air from N.E. Latter part raining & strong Wind. Steering N.W. under Lower Toppails

Sunday Jan 31<sup>st</sup>

This day Began with clear weather. Strong Wind from N.W. Steering S.W. under Lower Toppails at 5 o'clock P.M. Luffed to the Wind on Starboard Tack heading W by N middle part strong Wind from S.W. & rain squalls. Latter part clear
