Tuesday March 22nd

Began with fresh breeze from South
Heading under all Topsails Employed in
Stowed down ail at night was Ship to
the Eastward middle part the same
Latter part light Wind finest Stowed
down ail clear & pleasant weather

Wednesday March 23rd

This day Began with light breeze
from South heading E.S.E. under all Sails
at night Shorten Sail
middle part very light breeze from S.W.
Latter part the same under all Sails
Employed in ship's duty

Thursday Bark Petrel March 24th 1892

This day Began with cloudy weather
fresh breeze from S.W. under all Sails
Heading S.E. at night Packed Ship took
in light Sails heading W.S.W.
middle part light wind & fog Latter part
the same under all Sails Employed in ship's duty
Saw crew & Gallow of Lime Juice

Friday March 25th

This day Began with cloudy weather
fresh wind from South heading W.S.W.
at night Shorten Sails middle part strong breeze
Latter part the same Employed in ship's duty

Saturday March 26th

This day Began with cloudy weather strong
Wind from South under Topsails at night
took upper Topsails & main sail
middle part the same Latter part under
Lower Topsails Saw a finback Saw one steamer
go in South
