This day Began with cloudy weather strong winds from South heading W.S.W at night Shorten Sails Employed in Repairing main Topstay Sail Middle part very strong wind took in Fore Sail Latter part the same under all Topsails cloudy weather

Friday April 1 1892

This day Began with cloudy weather strong wind from South heading E.S.E under lower Topsails Middle part the same Latter part very much the same Employed in breaking out Berth water 4
