 This day Began with strong winds from South steering East under Lower Topsails at night were Ships heading W.S.W. Shorten sails middle part up to the Eastward again heading E.S.E. Set upper Topsails latter part the same moderate winds & clear weather

 Long 10° 40' East

Wednesday April 6th
 This day Began with fresh winds from S.S.W. heading W at night Shorten sails middle part moderate winds latter part strong winds under Lower Topsails foggy weather Employed in breaking out water

Thursday April 7th
 This day Began with strong winds from S.S.W. at night took in courses jib & spanker saw plenty finbacks middle part moderate winds & clear latter part the same employed in ship duty

Friday April 8th
 This day Began with fresh winds from S.W. heading E.S.E. under all sails at night packed ship heading W by N & Shorten sails saw finbacks middle part light winds latter part the same under all sails lowered for black fish did not strike clear weather
 Lat 18° 08' South
 Long 9° 39' East

Saturday Back Petrel April 9th 1892
 This day Began with clear & pleasant weather fresh wind from S.W. under all sails employed in white wash fore castle middle part light winds latter part the same employed in ship duty

Sunday April 10th
 This day Began with fresh wind from S.W. clear weather at night shorten sails middle part light winds saw a school of black fish latter fresh wind under all Topsails heading W.S.W. clear weather
 Lat 18° 40' South
 Long 10° 25' East

Monday April 11th
 This day Began with fresh winds from S.S.W. heading W.S.W. under all Topsails at night Shorten sails middle part the same latter part under all Topsails steering W.E. employed in breaking water & break out from Hall & stowed back again

Tuesday April 12th
 This day Began with fresh wind from South steering S.W. under all Topsails at took in upper Topsails luffed to on starboard tack middle part the same latter part strong winds steering E.N.E. under all sails saw finbacks
 Lat 17° 00' South
 10 39 East

Wednesday April 13th
 This day Began with strong wind from South steering W.E. by N 1/2 E at night Shorten sails & luffed to the wind on Port tack middle part the same latter steering N.E. under Topsails
