Parted & lost whale & Bow Boat missed the
Whale West Boat got 3 Small whales

Latter part cut whales in light winds

Employed in boiling middle part fresh
boiling Strong winds Latter part the
Same Employed in clearing deck

This day Began with Strong wind
from S.W. under all Topsails Steering

Shorten Sails middle part light winds
Latter part the Same under all Sails Employed
in Ship duty cloudy weather

Monday Park Pitel April 18 1892

This day Began with light winds from S.W.
under all Sails at night took in light Sails
Rove new falls Larboard & West Boats
middle part light winds & heavy Swells
Latter part the Same under all Sails Employed in
Stowed down sail clear weather

Tuesday April 19

This day Began with light winds from S.W.
Heading S by E under all Sails at night took
in light Sails Five men Malacca & Venegar
Caught 10 albacoria middle part calm
Latter part very light breeze from W.S.W. under
all Sails Steering S.E. by S Employed in Ship duty

Wednesday April 20

This day Began with fresh breeze from
W.S.W. heading S at sundown took in light
Sails middle part calm Latter part very light
breeze Steering S.E. by E under all Sails
Employed in Washing Ship out side

Thursday April 21

This day Began with fresh winds from
S.W. Steering S.E. by E at night took in light
Sails middle part the Same Hall back main
yard Latter part Steering E.S.E. saw School
of Black fish at 9 o'clock A.M. raised
Land Steering East saw 5 fishing Boats
