This day Begins with fresh breeze from SW at 4 o'clock PM got under weigh & proceeded to sea set all sail steering NW by N Shipped one man Rock da Silvia middle part Shorten sail latter part steering NW cloudy weather

Sunday May 1st 1892

This day Begins with very light breeze steering NNE at night Shorten sail & luffed to the wind on Starboard Tack middle part Calm latter part the same Employed in Ship duty

Monday May 2nd

This day Begins with light breeze from SW steering NNE under all sail at night Shorten sail middle part fresh breeze latter part the same under all sail steering NE clear & pleasant saw a fire backee Mr. Silvia 2nd mate Sick off duty

Tuesday May 3rd

This day Begins with fresh breeze from NW under all sail at night Shorten sail luffed to the wind on Port Tack heading NW middle part ware ship to the eastward latter part steering East under all sail Employed in Ship duty Mr. Silvia a better Rock da Silvia Sick

Wednesday May 4th 1892

This day Begins with pleasant weather light breeze from SW steering East at night ware ship took in sail heading NW middle part the same latter part under all sail heading SSE cloudy weather Employed in Ship duty Mr. Silvia came to his duty again Capt Reed Sick with Diarrhea Rock da Silvia are quite Sick

Thursday May 5th

This day Begins with fresh breeze from SW at night ware ship heading NW by N took in courses & upper topsails middle part the same latter part Strong breeze ware ship heading SE Employed in Straighten Rattline at main Capt Reed quite Sick with Diarrhea Mr. Smith 3rd mate Sick with Diarrhea Alexander McLeod Sick with Diarrhea

Friday May 6th

This day Begins with fresh breeze from SW steering NE at night Shorten sail & luffed to on Starboard Tack middle part the same latter part steering NNE fresh breeze Employed in Straighten the Rattline at main rigging Mr. Smith Still Sick with Diarrhea

Saturday May 7th

This day Begins with fresh breeze from SW steering NNE at night Shorten sail middle part light breeze latter part the same clear weather Employed in Ship duty Capt Reed Still Sick

Mr. Smith better Long 11th 18 East
