

Saturday Bark Petrel May 14th 1892

This day Breeze with very light breeze from NE under all sails at Sundown Capt Reed came on board Capt Reed getting quite well Rock da Silvia are little better to day middle part the same. Latter part under all sails clear weather Employed in ship duty Bark Canton in sight

Manuel Vieira was willing to come to his work again at 7 o'clock A.M. So did let him out he agreed to take Alfred's Andrine place in galley as Cook

Sunday May 15th

This day Breeze with very light breeze from SW clear & pleasant weather Capt Reed as well Rock Still Sick middle part calm Latter part very light breeze from SW heading W.N.W. under all sails Bark Canton in sight on Leeward Employed in breaking out Water Alfred Andrine Sick off duty with his Leg Swell up

Monday May 16th

This day Breeze with very light breeze from S.W. under all sails at night took in top sails & fore gallant sail middle part the same Latter part under all sails Employed in setting up mizzen Lower rigging clear weather Alfred Andrine Still Sick with his Leg Swell up Rock da Silvia are well

Tuesday May 17th 1892

This day Breeze with very light breeze from SW heading W by N under all sails at night took in light sail at 2 o'clock P.M. used School of Black fish lowered all the Boats Leeward Boats struck Bark Canton in sight to the Leeward middle part fresh wind Latter part the same under all sails heading W
Lat 10° 38 South
Long 8° 29 East

Wednesday May 18th

This day Breeze with light breeze from SW under all sails at 1 o'clock Capt Reed went on Board Bark Canton at 5 P.M. Breeze to backing Black fish Break out Cask Flour 15th Bogs middle part fresh winds Latter part the same heading W.N.W. under top sails & gallant sail Employed in straighten up rigging in mizzen Breeze Alfred Andrine not much better yet

Thursday May 19th

This day Breeze with cloudy weather fresh Breeze from South at 3 o'clock P.M. Packed Ship heading E.S.E. took in upper top sails & light sails middle part the same Latter part Packed Ship to the Westward Set top sails & main gallant sail cloudy day Mr. Silvia Sick again with Quinaria & off duty Far down main Breeze

Friday May 20th

This day Breeze with fresh wind from South at night took in light sails middle part the same Latter part under all sails pleasant Employed in ship duty Mr. Silvia still about the same
