Lower all the Boats for Blackfish Starboard Mast & Starboard Boat got Blackfish at 4 o'clock took Blackfish a long side at night took in light sails one sail in sight to the leeward middle part fresh breeze Latter part light breeze under all sails at 9.30 o'clock A.M. spoke B.K. Canton Capt. Hauland came on Board cloudy weather

Tuesday June 7th

This day Begins with very light breeze from S.W. under all sails at night took in light sails in company with Bark Canton middle part Calm Latter part fresh winds under all sails clear weather Employed in sitting up but Stays Bark Canton are in sight

This day Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. under all sails heading W at night took in light sails Breaking out water middle part fresh breeze Latter part very light breeze under all sails at 9.30 A.M. spoke Schooner Clara. L. Sparks Capt. Benton came on Board Mr. Domingos are little better to day Alfred Andrew are well & come to his duty

Saturday June 11th

This day Begins with very light breeze from N.W. at night took in light sails in company with Clara. L. Sparks middle part the same Latter part under all sails Steering E.E.
