

Sunday Bark Petrel June 19th 1892

This day Begins with fresh breeze from SW heading W by N under all sails at night Ware Ship to the Eastward one sail in to the windward middle part Calm Latter part the same Employed in breaking out mallasses at 11.30 A.M. Spoke Schooner Agate Capt Winslow came on board

Monday June 20th

This day Begins with very light breeze from SW under all sails in company with Schooner Agate & Sold Capt Winslow one Cask 112 Salons Half full of mallasses & Sat one Bag of Yams from him middle part light breeze Latter Strong breeze from South Saw Spout on weather beam

Rock da Silva here not much better to day

Tuesday June 21st

This day Begins with Strong breeze from South heading W by S under all sails at Dark Ship heading S E by E took in fore Battant sail & Gaff Toppail Sat one Cask 148 Salons from Schooner Agate middle part light winds Latter part fresh breeze under all sails Employed in Ship's duty clear & cloudy weather. Rock da Silva Still Sick

Wednesday June 22nd

This day Begins with cloudy weather very light breeze from South under all sails at night were Ship & took in light sails heading E S E middle part & Latter part the same

Thursday Bark Petrel June 23rd 1892

This day Begins with fresh breeze from S W heading S S E under all sails at 4.30 o'clock P.M. Loure for Black fish Mutt Boat got one Black fish & Bow Boat got another Black fish Let Crew have 1 1/2 Salons of Pickles middle part Strong breeze Latter part very light breeze Saw two Hump Back Sperm to the Leeward & Saw one School of Black fish Rock da Silva are very Sick to day Suppose to be the Liver Complen

Friday June 24th

This day Begins with Calm weather at 1.30 o'clock Loured for Black fish did not Struck & Saw one Humpback Sperm to the Leeward middle part Calm Latter part the same Employed in boiling Black fish Rock are little better to day

Saturday June 25th

This day Begins with Calm Employed in Ship's duty Saw a School of Black fish middle part fresh breeze under all sails heading S S E Latter part very light air Saw School of Black fish Lat 10°20 South Rock not much better to day Long 10°07 East

Sunday June 26th

This day Begins with clear & pleasant very light breeze from N S W heading South middle part the same Latter part Calm Employed in Breaking out fresh water
