

Monday B.R. Petrel at Sea June 27th 1892

This day Begins with very light breeze from S.W. heading S.E. under all Sails middle part were ship heading W by N latter part the same clear & pleasant weather employed in ship duty Rock da Silva he is about the same sick

Lat 10.40 South
Long 10.12 East

Tuesday June 28th

This day Begins with cloudy weather fresh wind from S.W. heading S.E. under all Sails at 4 o'clock P.M. Lawrence all the Boats for Black fish & did not struck middle part fresh breeze latter part the same under all Sails saw whales spout to the windward one risen & did not see them again

Wednesday June 29th

This day Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.E. under all Sails saw school of Black fish going to the leeward middle part the same latter part very much the same saw a school of Black fish employed in ship's duty foggy weather

Rock da Silva still sick with heavy cough

Thursday June 30th

This day Begins with calm weather employed in fixing jib & main Payail middle part a light air latter part the same saw school of Black fish & two humpbacks clear weather employed in fixing jib & main Payail

Friday B.R. Petrel July 1st 1892

This day Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. heading W by S under all Sails clear & pleasant weather employed in fixing main Payail Seryo Baptista took piece of canvas in fore-castle & Capt Reed sends him to masthead & he refuse to go & he was put in Irons & one piece of canvas was stold but nobody know who took it middle part light breeze latter part the same cloudy weather employed in breaking out fresh water

Long 9.08 East

Saturday July 2nd

This day Begins with very light breeze from S.W. heading W by S under all Sails Seryo Baptista he is in Irons get let crew have Pickle to day half bucket full middle part fresh breeze latter part the same at 8.30 o'clock A.M. saw B.R. Sunbeam with 4 Boats down chasing whales and the whales went to the windward cloudy weather Seryo Baptista he is still in Irons let have Pot of fresh water & cake of hard bread

Sunday July 3rd

This day Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. at 3 o'clock P.M. raised another school of Sperm whales goin to the windward & forward all the Boats & also Sunbeam lowered 4 Boats & whales goin to the windward quick at night Boats came on board middle part took in light Sails latter part the same cloudy weather at 8.30 o'clock spoke B.R. Sunbeam Capt Reed went on board & Capt Reed got a back board from Capt Holton 753 lbs board
