This day Began with Strong Wind from South heading W by S at night took in upper Topsails. Cloudy weather. Middle part the same. Latter part very much the same cloudy weather.

Mr. Smith Still Sick. Rock he is about the same.

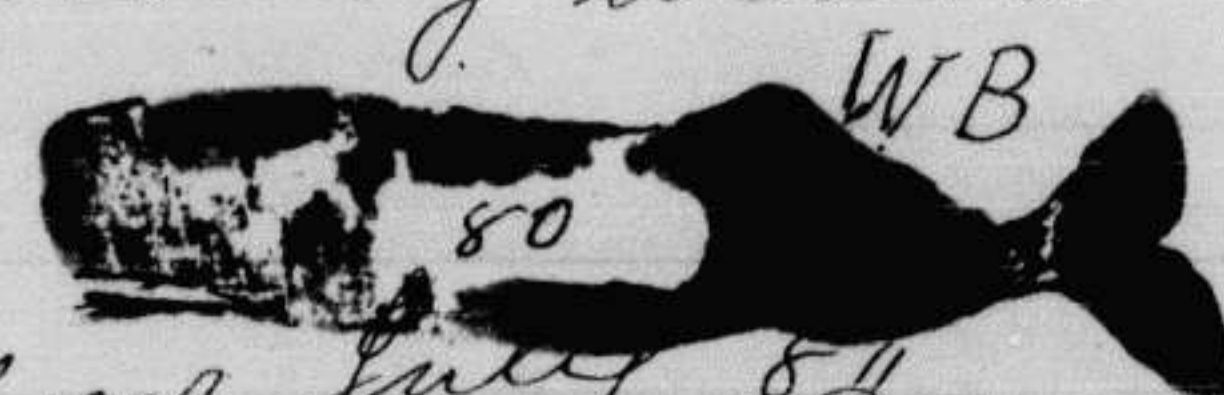

Latter part very Strong breeze at 6.30 o'clock A.M. chased a School of Sperm whales on weather beam at 11 o'clock. Lowered Larboard Starboard & West Boat & Larboard Boat. Got two small whales & West Boat got a Large whale. Cloudy weather.
