 night took in light sails
 Breaking out Cask Flour 18 Bage
 middle part calm Latter part light
 winds under all sails cloudy day
 Capt Reed Employed in Repairing
 Mast Boat

Wednesday July 20th
 This day Began with very light
 breeze from S.W. at night took in
 fore gallant sail & Gaff Topsail at 10 o'clock
 Mr. Loure for Thompson & the whale
 went to the Leeward with 2 Boats came
 on board middle part calm Latter part
 fresh winds from South under all sails
 clear weather Employed in breaking out water
 Alexander McLeod as well and return to his
 duty again & also Diego Ramon

Thursday July 21st
 This day Began with fresh winds
 from South under all sails at night took
 in light sails heading N.S.W. middle part strong
 winds Latter part the same under Topsails

Friday Bark Petrel July 22nd 1892
 This day Began with strong winds from
 South heading S.E. by E under Topsails
 Saw White water on Lee quarter steeple for
 it & did not see it again at night took
 in main sail & upper Topsails
 Mr. Smith Sick again off duty
 Gave crew three Salons of vinegar middle part
 very strong winds Latter part moderate set
 all sails heading S.E. by E cloudy weather
 Packed out Cask Pork & Bble

Saturday July 23rd
 This day Began with cloudy weather
 light winds heading S.E. by E at 10 o'clock
 Gallant sail & Gaff Topsails Let crew have
 some Pickles middle part light breeze from
 South heading S.E. by E Latter part the same
 under all sails Employed in ship duty
 Mr. Smith Still Sick

Sunday July 24th
 This day Began with cloudy weather
 very light breeze from South heading S.E. by E
 under all sails at night took in light sails
 middle part strong breeze Latter part the
 same cloudy weather Employed in
 Repairing Larboard Boat

Monday July 25th
 This day Began with cloudy weather
 light breeze from S.W. steering East under
 all sails at night took in light sails &
 hall up courses hall Back main yard
 Squ-a School of Black fish middle part the
 same Latter part cloudy Landed for Black
 fish did not struck one sail in sight
