Boatswain again Mr. Silva still on shore

Rice on board 10 Cask Bread 1 Cask Flour
1 Cask Towline 1 Barrel Beans 1 Barrel Pickles
& 1 Barrel Lime Juice 2 Boat Load wood
Middle part rain Squalls Latter very much
the same Employed in Painting & Ship
Discharge Alexander MacLeod with
mutual consent

Thursday Sept 8

This day Begins with Squally weather
Rice on board 4 Cask Flour 1 Cask Vinegar
1 Cask Clothing & Store 1 Cask Butter
2 Coils Rope & Sacks Sugar & 1 Cask
Sugar Sold 10 Pieces cloth middle part
rain Squalls Latter part very much
the same Sold 37 Lbs whale Teeth

Friday Bark Petrel Sept 9, 1892. at St Helena

This day Begins with Squally & rainy weather
Rice on Board 9 Tons of fresh water middle part
Blowing hard & rain Latter part very much the
same Rice on Board 12 Tons of fresh water
Second mate Mr. Silva still on shore
Shipped Frank Mallone Stowed

Saturday Sept 10

This day Begins with Squally weather Rice
on board 3 Boats Load of wood & 1 Case of
barreine middle Blowing hard & rain Latter
very much the same

Alfred Anderson & George Durram Absent

Sunday Sept 11

This day Begins with Squally weather
& rain Sunk Port water on shore middle
part raining Latter part clear Port water
came on board Sold 6 Pieces of cloth to Capt. Bunt

Monday Sept 12

This day Begins with clear weather Rice
on board 3 Boats Loaded of wood from shore
middle part the same Latter part pleasant &
Received on board 5 Tons of fresh water from shore
& 2 Boats of tomatoes from Schooner Clara L. Sparks
Alfred Anderson & George Durram still absent
Mr. Silva still on shore

Tuesday Sept 13

This day Begins with fine weather
Employed in Painting Ship in side &
Received on board 20 Sacks of Potatoes from shore
& 687 Lbs Lbs Pumpkins middle part fine
Latter part the same Sunk Starboard water
Shore on Liberty Dr. Anderson & George Durram
Discharge Mr. Silva still on shore
