This day Begins with fine weather Received on board 40⁺ Sacks of Potatoes & 13 tuns of mutton. Pumpkins & Some Rails & 2 Pige middle part fine weather Latter part the same Starboard watch came on board Sends Port watch ashore on Liberty Employed in Painting Ship in Side Mr Selva came on board

Thursday Sept 15th

This day Begins with fine weather Employed in Painting Ship in Side Received on board 100⁺ lb Onions Port watch came on board & Sends Starboard Shore on Liberty Shipped Antonio De Cruz as Boat-

Friday Sept 16

This day Begins with fine weather Employed in Painting Ship in Side middle part raining Latter part clear finest Painting Ship Sends Port watch Shore on Liberty received on board 14 Sacks of Sweet Potatoes & 6 Sacks Jam

Saturday Sept 17th

This day Begins with clear weather Employed in Ship duty middle part Squally Latter part the same Port watch came on board

Sunday Sept 18th

This day Begins with Squally weather middle part the same Latter part very much the same Lorinda Boat absent

Monday B.K. Petrel September 19th 1892

This day Begins with clear & pleasant weather Shipped Stewards Yarn for Boatstew & Shipped William Stevens Charles Asrock & William Hopkins at 11 30 A.M. Mate Call on Crew to heave short & the crew refused & they say that they want to see the Counsel & the Capt Reed Bring Counsel on board Counsel talk with crew & was willing to go to work at 4:20 o'clock P.M. got under way & Proceeded to Sea Lorinda Boat desertion middle part fresh wind Steering W by N under all Sails Latter part the same Employed in Ship duty

Tuesday Sept 20th

This day Begins with fresh wind from S.E. Steering W by N under all Sails middle part Squally weather fresh wind latter part clear under all Sails Employed in Ship duty

Wednesday Sept 21st

This day Begins with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from S.E. under all Sails middle part Squally Latter part clear Employed in Ship duty

Thursday Sept 22nd

This day Begins with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from S.E. Steering W under all Sails middle part rain Squally Latter part the same Employed in Ship duty
