This day Began with fresh winds from S.E. Steering W.S.W. under all Sails middle part very light winds Latter part the same Employed in Painting all the Boats

Tuesday Oct 4th

This day Began with Strong Winds from S.E. Steering S.W. by W under all Sails fresh Painting a Boats Saw Whales brich twice on weather Bar middle part fresh breeze from Eastward Latter part the same

Wednesday Oct 5th

This day Began with Strong winds from Eastward Steering S.W. by W under all Sails Employed in breaking out water middle part blowing very Strong took in light Sails Latter part the same let the crew have Boots & Shoes

Lat 30° 20' South
Long 40° 43' West

Thursday Oct 6th

This day Began with Strong wind from S.E. Steering S.W. under Topsails saw plenty fin back middle part light winds Latter part clear & pleasant Steering S.W. by W under all Sails

Friday Oct 7th

This day Began with light wind from S.E. Steering S.W. by W Saw Whale turn flock middle part very light breeze Latter part the same clear weather Lat 32° 30' Long 43° 46' W

Saturday B^k Petrel October 8th 1892

This day Began with Clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from S.E. Steering S.W. by W under all Sails Saw fin back middle part fresh winds Latter part the same under all Sails

Lat 34° 10' South
Long 45° 18' West

Sunday Oct 9th

This day Began with Cloudy weather fresh winds from S.E. Steering S.W. under all Sails at night took in Light Sails middle part Strong wind from S.E. Steering S.W. Cloudy weather Latter part raining took in upper Topsails Blowing hard

Monday Oct 10th

This day Began with moderate S.W. wind from S.W. under Lower main Topsails Lay to on Port Jack middle part blowing hard from S.W. & clear Latter part wore Ship heading S.S.E.

Tuesday Oct 11th

This day Began with Strong winds from S.W. heading S.S.E. at 5 o'clock P.M. way Ship again heading W by S under Lower Topsails middle part moderate Latter part calm Employed in breaking water
