This day Begins with calm weather at night took in main sail & light sails at 5.30 o'clock A.M. Henry Walker was sleeping in fore castle when was his watch on deck & mate went to call him & he threatening to cutt mate with knife so he was put in Irons middle part very light breeze from Eastward Steering South latter part wind the same Steering S.W. under all sails clear weather

Thursday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from Eastward Steering West under all sails at night took in a light sail Henry Walker Promise that he would not make any more trouble in ship here after so did let him loose from Irons middle part Strong winds from N.E. latter part Steering N.W. by S under Topsails saw finbacks

Lat 36° 10' South  
Long 42° 30' West

Friday Oct 14<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with very strong Wind from N.E. under Lower Topsails Steering S.W. at 5.30 o'clock P.M. took in fore Topsail & luffed to the wind on Port Tack one sail in sight going Eastward middle part blowing hard & rain latter part rain squalls set Topsail & fore sail one sail in sight Steering N.E.

Saturday Oct 15<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with Squally weather at night Strong Wind from S.W. heading N.W. by N. at took in fore sail middle the same latter part under Topsails Steering N.W. wind from S.E.

Sunday October 16<sup>th</sup> 1892 Bark Petrel at Sea

This day Begins with Strong wind from S.E. heading N.E. under Topsails at Sundown took in upper Topsails middle part light breeze from East heading S.E. latter part fresh wind under all Topsails clear weather

Monday Oct 17<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with clear weather fresh Wind from East heading S.E. at night took in upper Topsails middle part the same latter part under all Topsails heading S.E.

Lat 37° 03' South  
Long 50° 17' West

Tuesday Oct 18<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with cloudy weather Strong wind from E heading S.E. under Topsails at took in upper Topsails saw finback middle part light breeze latter part Strong breeze from East heading N.W. by E cloudy weather

Lat 37° 12' South  
Long 50° 01' West

Wednesday Oct 19<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with fresh wind from East heading S.E. by S at night Shorten sail middle part the same latter part Strong winds from N.E. under Topsails cloudy weather one sail in sight to the Windward

Thursday Oct 20<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with Strong wind from N.E. at night Shorten sail saw whale feed one sail in sight to the windward middle part light wind latter part Strong Wind under Topsails cloudy weather saw a finback Manuel Da Silva & Rock Da Silva got in fight south was sent to mast head
