This day Bigine with moderate gale wind from S.W. Steering S.E. by S under Lower main Toppails at 3 o'clock P.M. She gave heavy Roll & took forward Davits of Bow Boat & Lost the Boat with every thing in it at 4:30 Spoke B.K. Sunbeam Steering East Luffed to on Port Tack middle part winds moderate latter part Squally weather at 10:30 o'clock A.M. raised two whales gain about S.W. thought it was R. whale they was gain quick Comp. Ship 500 Stracks

Sunday Oct 30th

This day Bigine with light winds from S.W. & E under all Sails Steering S.E. by E at night Shorten Sails & luffed to the winds on Port Tack Hoisting Star & Sunbeam are in sight to the windward middle part Blowing hard Gorse Wing main Toppail & rain Squall latter part clear Employed in Breaking out Boat mast & Aree

Monday Oct 31st

This day Bigine with very light Wind from S.W. heading W by S Saw one Humpback middle part the same latter part foggy weather fresh breeze Employed in break out water

Tuesday November 1st 1892

This day Bigine with foggy weather very light breeze from West heading S by W Saw plenty fin backs middle part clear up fog & fresh breeze latter part Squally weather Employed in getting Bow Boat ready

Wednesday November 2nd 1892

This day Bigine with Squally weather under Lower Toppails wind from S.W. at night took in Fore Toppail middle part very light winds latter part Squally & Strong wind under Lower Toppails Employed in Ship duty

Long 46° 42' West

Thursday Nov 3rd

This day Bigine with Squally weather Strong wind from S.W. under Lower Toppails middle part moderate breeze latter part very strong winds from West under Lower Toppails Employed in Ship duty Saw fin back

Lat 37° 00' South
Long 46° 45' West

Friday Nov 4th

This day Bigine with Strong Winds from West heading S by W under Lower Toppails Clear weather middle part moderate wind latter part calm put out Bow Boat Saw plenty fin backs

Saturday Nov 5th

This day Bigine with light breeze from East Steering West by S under all Sails at night Shorten Sails middle part the same latter part Strong wind from S.E. Steering W by S under Lower Toppails cloudy weather

Sunday Nov 6th

This day Bigine with Strong wind from S.E. Steering W by S at 3 o'clock P.M. Luffed to the winds on Port Tack heading S by W took in Fore Toppail middle part moderate winds latter part the same Steering W by S under all the Toppails at 11:30 o'clock Spoke B.K. Sunbeam Steering West Lat 37° 40' Long 48° 53'
