This day Began with clear & pleasant weather Strong breeze from South Steering W by S at Sundown War Ship heading E by S took in upper Topsails & Courses Saw plenty finbacks middle part light breeze latter part squally Employed in breaking out water.

Tuesday Nov 8th

This day Began with fresh breeze from South under all Sails at 4:30 Pm Spoke B.K. Sunbeam Capt Reed went on board at night Shorten Sails middle part very light latter part wind from S.E. Steering W by S rainy weather took in upper Topsails

Wednesday Nov 9th

This day Began with Strong winds from S.S.W. at night took Lower fore Topsail middle part moderate wind latter part Strong wind & squally weather under Lower main Topsail Lat 37° 38' South Long 49° 57' West

Thursday Nov 10th

This day Began with Strong winds from S.E. under Lower main Topsail Heading W.S.W. middle part moderate wind latter part Strong winds from South heading W.S.W. set fore Sail & fore Topsail Jib & Spanker Lat 37° 18' S Give crew mallowee Long 50° 27' W

Friday Nov 11th

This day Began with moderate breeze from South heading W.S.W. at night were Ships heading E.S.E. middle part & latter part Calm Employed in Ship duty

Saturday Bark Petrel November 12th 1892

This day Began with fresh breeze from N.W. Steering S.E. by S under all Sails at night Shorten Sails one Sail in Sight middle part light breeze & cloudy weather latter part raining fresh breeze Steering S.E. by S under Topsails Lat 36° 47' South Long 61° 14' West

Sunday Nov 13th

This day Began with clear & pleasant weather fresh wind from S.S.W. heading S.E. by S Saw plenty finbacks middle part Strong wind latter part the same under Lower Topsails Employed in Ship duty

Monday Nov 14th

This day Began with Strong wind S.E. under Lower Topsails at 3 o'clock Pm Spoke Bark. Harming Star & Kathleen Capt Reed went on Board, Harming Star Bark Kathleen Pick up the Boat that we last October 29 & safe all the Crafts & the Boat was all Stowed didn't safe the Boat middle very light breeze latter part calm

Tuesday Nov 15th

This day Began with light breeze from N.W. Steering S.E. under all Sails at 6 o'clock Pm reared two Sperm whales coming to the windward three Boats lowered the whales went to the windward quick Starboard capsized Strong breeze B.K. Kathleen in Sight to the leeward at night Shorten Sails middle part light breeze & heavy weather latter part light fog Bark Kathleen in Sight
