for Martine are well & return to his duty again
Mr. Domingos & Rock are still sick

This day Bigine with clear & pleasant weather
fresh breeze from West steering E 1/4 E set main
gallant sail Employed in ship duty
middle part fresh wind took gallant sail & upper
Topsails latter part strong winds Employed
in breaking water for stowed down ail

Thursday Dec 1st

This day Bigine with very strong winds from
West steering E 1/4 E under Topsails cloudy weather
Mr. Domingos are well & return to his duty again
middle part moderate breeze latter part the same
Employed in stowed down ail clear &
pleasant weather Lat 36° 00' South
Long 36° 12' West

Friday Dec 2nd

This day Bigine with fine weather fresh
breeze from West steering NE by E set
main gallant sail finish stowing down ail
60 Barrels middle part the same latter part
strong winds Employed in breaking out Beef
saw one sail steering to the Eastward
Lat 35° 30' South
Long 38° 17' West
