 in washing a Ship in Side Middle part
 light wind Latter part fresh winds from
 South Steering E by S under all Sails
 Clear & pleasant weather Lat 35° 25' South
 Long 30° 31' West

Sunday Dec 4th

This day Began with very light breeze
 from East heading S by S under all sails
 at night took in light sails Middle part
 fresh breeze from NW Steering E by S
 Latter part raining & Strong winds
 Steering S by E

Monday Dec 5th

This day Began with Cloudy weather
 Strong wind from NW Steering E by S
 under Lower Topsails Middle part took
 in fore Topsail & heaved to the wind on
 Port Tack heading North Blowing hard
 Lat 36° 13' South
 Long 27° 16' West

Tuesday Dec 6th

This day Began with Gale wind from
 NW under goose wing main Topsail lying
 to on Port Tack heavy squalls
 Middle part Blowing very hard Latter part
 moderate winds & heavy squalls Nicholas Suarez
 fell on deck & hurt himself quite bad
 Lat 35° 46' S
 Long 27° 00' W

Wed

Dec 7th

This day Began with fresh gale wind from
 SW at 4 o'clock P.M. moderate ware Ship heading
 S by E Middle part heavy squalls Steering S by E
 Latter part the same employed in breaking water

Thursday Bark Petrel December 8th 1892

This Began with clear & pleasant weather
 Wind from Westward Steering E by S under Topsails
 at night took in main Topsails Middle part
 Wind from East heading S by E Latter part
 the same Employed in ship duty
 Lat 35° 45' South
 Long 24° 55' West

Friday Dec 9th

This day Began with light winds from E
 heading S by E at 3:30 P.M. Loure for Black fish
 all the Boats & Black fish went to the windward
 quick & the Boats came on board at night ware
 Ship heading S by S took in main gallantsail
 & Flying Jib Nicholas Suarez still sick
 Middle part very light breeze from S by E
 Latter part the same under all sails Employed
 in breaking out Port Clear & pleasant
 Saw Crew 3 gallons of Pickle

Saturday Dec 10th

This day Began with clear & pleasant weather
 fresh breeze from S by E at 1 o'clock P.M. Apple
 B.K. morning Star Capt King came on board
 carrying way Band on Flying Jib Boom
 Middle part fresh wind Latter part Strong winds
 from NE Employed in putting Bands on
 Flying Jib Boom B.K. Morning Star in sight

Sunday Dec 11th

This day Began with very Strong wind
 from NE heading E by S under lower main Topsails
 Middle part blowing very hard & rain Latter part
 the same Nicholas Suarez still sick & off duty
