

Monday Bark Rebel December 12th 1892

This day Began with very strong winds from S^W steering N^E under lower main topsails heavy swell from N^E pump stop 320 strokes middle part moderate & heavy swell from S^W latter part the same set topsails & gallantails steering N^E by E
Lat 35° 55' South
Long 24° 10' West

Tuesday Dec 13th

This day Began with very light breeze from W steering E by S at night took in Gallant sail & upper topsails luffed to the wind on Port Tack middle part winds from North latter part the same under all sails B^K Morning Star in sight to the leeward clear & pleasant weather
Lat 36° 00' South
Long 23° 32' West

Wednesday Dec 14th

This day Began with clear & pleasant weather light breeze from North under all sails steering S^W Bark - Morning Star are in sight to the leeward chasing whales at night shorten sails & luffed to the wind on Port Tack heading N^E by E Nicholas Suarez are well & return to his duty again middle part light winds latter part squally weather saw plenty fin backs
Lat 36° 16' South
Long 23 27 West

Thursday Dec 15th

This day with fresh wind from North under all sail at 7 o'clock P.M. lowered for Right whale saw three whales to the windward & lowered three Boats & the Boats saw whales once & night came the Boats come on board at 8:30 P.M.

Middle part squally weather shorten sails latter part strong wind from West at 6:30 a.m. raised two Right Whales lowered Larboard & West & Bow Boat & Ban Boat Galled the whales & whales went to the windward & Boats come on board
Lat 36° 20' South
Long 23° 08' West

Friday Dec 16th

This day Began with fresh breeze from West under topsails steering E by S at 5 o'clock raised two Right Whales & lowered Larboard West & Bow Boat West Boat struck whale at 8:30 o'clock took whale a long side B^K Morning Star are in sight to the windward middle part employed in getting ready for cut latter part cut the whale in fine & pleasant weather wind from N^E



Saturday Dec 17th

This day Began with fresh wind from N^E & cloudy weather employed in boiling B^K Morning Star are in sight middle part clear latter part the same at 8 o'clock a.m. raised two Right whales goin to the windward lowered Larboard West & Bow Boat & the whales went to the windward greek & Boats come on board

Sunday Dec 18th

This day Began with squally weather fresh wind from N^E at night took in upper topsails Bark Morning Star are in sight to the windward middle light wind employed in boiling latter part the same clear & pleasant
