

Monday Bark Petrel December 19th 1892

This day Began with light breeze from NE heading East at Two o'clock Two raised Two Right whales on Lee quarter coming to the windward quick lowered Larboard Mast & Bow Boat & the whales went to the windward quick Boats came on board at night Shorten Sails B.K. Morning Star are in sight middle part very light wind Latter part the same at 8 Am raised Three Right whales on Larboard coming to the windward & got killed by ship at 9 o'clock Am raised Two more Right whales coming to the windward Lower Larboard Mast & Bow Boat Larboard Boat struck at 12 o'clock took whale a long side



Tuesday Dec 20

L B

This day Began with very light breeze from NE & fresh cut whale in middle part fresh wind from SE Latter part the same at 8:30 o'clock Am lowered Larboard & Mast Boat for Right whale Larboard Boat struck plenty whales in sight at 4 Pm took whale a long side



Wednesday Dec 21st L B

This day Began with fresh winds from SE Employed in boiling & stowed down oil middle part strong breeze Latter part the same Employed in cutting whale & boiling

Thursday December 22 1892

This day Began with cloudy weather fresh winds from NE & fresh cut whale in middle part light winds Latter part the same Employed in boiling & stowed down oil Clear & pleasant weather at 6:30 Am saw Two Right whales go to the Larboard quite quick didn't lower

Friday Dec 23rd

This day Began with fresh winds from SE & pleasant Employed in boiling & stowed down oil 120 Barrels middle part the same Latter part raining & strong wind from SE

Saturday Dec 24th

This day Began with light fog wind from SE Employed in boiling middle part strong wind from SE Latter part the same Employed in boiling Clear weather

Sunday Dec 25th

This day Began with strong wind from NE Clear & pleasant weather middle part the same Latter part Employed stowed down oil & boiling cloudy weather

Monday Dec 26th

This day Began with cloudy strong winds from SE under our main Top sail Employed in stowed down oil middle part moderate winds Latter part very light breeze from SE Employed stowed down oil
