This day Begins with rain squalls Strong Wind from S.W. under Lower main Topsail Lying to on Port Tack middle part moderate wind set fore Topsail latter part light breeze under Topsails Cooper employed in setting up Casks

Saturday Jan 7<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with very light breeze from South heading E.S.E. Clear weather middle part calm latter part very light breeze from South Steering S.W. under all Sails Employed in Ship's duty

Sunday Jan 8<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with calm weather at night took in light Sails middle part & latter part calm

Monday Jan 9<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with calm weather Employed in breaking out water middle part & latter part the same Employed in Ship's duty

Tuesday Jan 10<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with very light breeze from S.W. Steering S.E. under all Sails at 4 o'clock P.M. Lower all the Boats for Black fish & all got fast Starboard Boat got 2 West Boat 2 Bow Boat 4 Starboard Boat 2 Black fish middle part calm latter part very light breeze from S.W. under all Sails at 6:30 o'clock A.M. raised a large sperm whale on Lubbock lower all the Boats & whale went to the windward did not show no chance clear & pleasant weather

Wednesday Bark Petrel January 11<sup>th</sup> 1893

This day Begins with clear & pleasant weather Employed in Boiling Black fish middle part Strong Wind from W. latter part the same finish Boiling Black fish

Thursday Jan 12<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with Strong wind from West Steering S.S.W. under all Topsails at night took in all the Sails but Lower main Topsail & luffed to the wind on Starboard Tack middle part foggy weather latter part the same

Friday Jan 13<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with Strong winds from West Steering S.W. under Lower Topsails at night Shorten Sails & luffed to the wind on Starboard Tack middle part the same latter part employed in Stowed down Black fish oil & Break out water

Saturday Jan 14<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with Strong Winds from S.W. heading North under Lower Topsails & raining quite hard middle part & latter part Blowing hard from S.W. under Lower main Topsail

Sunday Jan 15<sup>th</sup>

This day Begins with Strong Wind from S.W. under Lower main Topsail at 4 o'clock P.M. set fore Topsail heading S by E middle part moderate latter part the same under all Topsails cloudy weather employed in Ship's duty
