

Sunday Bark Petrel at Sea February 5th 1893

This day Breeze with very light winds from S.W. Steering East middle part winds from South heading S.W. & latter part very light breeze employed in washing Whale Bone Clear & pleasant weather

Monday Feb 6th

This day Breeze with clear & pleasant weather very little air from South employed in washing whale Bones at night took in light sails middle part calm latter part light breeze from S.E. heading E.N.E. under all sails employed in washing whale Bone

Tuesday Feb 7th

This day Breeze with clear & pleasant weather light breeze from S.E. heading E.N.E. employed in washing whale Bone & Bundle up the same time at 7 o'clock P.M. wore ship middle part squally latter part the same employed in Bundling Whale Bone

Wednesday Feb 8th

This day Breeze with light breeze from S.E. heading South at night took in light sails middle part very light breeze & rain squalls latter part employed in repairing St. John. Feb & Bind on main Gallant sail

Thursday Feb 9th

This day Breeze with calm weather at night rain squalls middle part squally latter part fresh breeze from S.E. under all sails employed in breaking out water & Bread Clear & Pleasant weather

Friday Bark Petrel at Sea February 10th 1893

This day Breeze with very light breeze from S.E. heading South under all sails middle part calm latter part employed in washing a ship outside

Saturday Feb 11th

This day Breeze with calm weather employed in washing a ship outside middle part very light air from E.W. Steering S.E. by E. under all sails clear & pleasant employed in ship duty

Sunday Feb 12th

This day Breeze with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from N.W. Steering S.E. by E. under all sails middle part fresh latter part strong breeze & rain from West Steering S.E. took in light sails

Monday Feb 13th

This day Breeze with strong winds from West Steering S.E. at 3 o'clock P.M. luffed to the wind on Starboard Tack took in upper Topsails & fore Topsail at night wore ship heading N.W. middle part heavy squalls latter part the same

Tuesday Feb 14th

This day Breeze with gale winds from S.W. & heavy rain squalls Lying to on Starboard Tack middle part heavy squalls latter part the same under lower main Topsail

Wednesday Feb 15th

This day Breeze with squally weather from S.W. heading N.W. under lower main Topsail gave crew Malacca middle part moderate winds latter part the same set all the Topsails Steering S.E. by S clear weather employed in repairing main Topstaysail
