This day Bazine with very light breeze from S.E. heading South by W at night took in main Gallant Sails & Flying jibb middle part Squally weather Latter part clear fresh winds at 9 o'clock A.M. passed a School of Large Sperm whales hauled Starboard & West Bow Boat West Boat & Bow Boat Struck Capt Reed head West Boat Mr. Silvia Still Sick off duty

Tuesday Feb 28

This day Bazine with Squally weather light winds took whales along side at dark middle part clear weather Employed in getting ready for cutting Latter part fine weather Employed in cutting whales

Wednesday March 1<sup>st</sup> 1893

This day Bazine with calm weather Employed in cutting whales middle part Employed in boiling Latter part finish cutting

Thursday March 2<sup>nd</sup>

This day Bazine with clear & pleasant weather Employed in boiling middle part the same Latter part fresh winds from North Employed in boiling Mr. Silvia Still Sick off duty

Friday March 3<sup>rd</sup>

This day Bazine with clear & pleasant weather fresh winds from North heading N.E. by E middle part boiling Latter part Squally weather Employed in boiling

Saturday March 4<sup>th</sup>

This day Bazine with cloudy weather fresh breeze from N.W. Employed in boiling middle part finish boiling Latter part pleasant Mr. Silvia Still Sick off duty

Sunday Bait Pital March 5<sup>th</sup> 1893

This day Bazine with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from S.W. Steering N by N middle part winds from South Latter part the same Employed in Stowed down ail

Monday March 6<sup>th</sup>

This day Bazine with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from South Employed in Stowed ail let crew have 3 Salms of Vinegar middle & Latter part light breeze finish Stowed down ail 115 Barrels set told

Tuesday March 7<sup>th</sup>

This day Bazine with light breeze from South heading W.S.W. under Topsails at night took in upper Topsails middle part very light breeze Latter part the same under all Sails Capt Reed Employed in repairing Bow Boat Mr. Silvia Still Sick

Wednesday March 8<sup>th</sup>

This day Bazine with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from South heading W.S.W. at Sundown were Ship heading E.S. & took in light Sails middle part very light breeze from West Latter part Strong Winds N.W. Steering E.N.E. under all Sails

Thursday March 9<sup>th</sup>

This day Bazine with Strong Winds from N.W. Steering E by S 1/2 S at night Shorten Sails middle part Squally Latter part the same Employed in breaking out Sugar & Flour

Friday March 10<sup>th</sup>

This day Bazine with Squally weather Strong Winds from West Steering East under Topsails at 2 o'clock P.M. took in upper Topsails & Luffed to the wind on Port Tack at night took in Lower fore Topsails heading N by N middle part Blowing quite hard & rain Squally Latter part very rough heavy hail
