Saturday April 8th

Begins with fine weather watch came on board & Sailed Port watch Shore on Liberty

Sunday April 9th

This day Begins with pleasant weather Port watch came on board & Sailed Starboard Shore on Liberty

Monday April 10th

This day Begins with fine weather watch came on board at 11 o'clock a m gat under way & proceeded to Sea Shipped Joaquim Santana John Farnonides Antonio Vira & Arthur Scott

This day Begins with very light breeze from SE steering NW under all Sails at Sundown took in light Sails reared Island of Ascension right head of the Ship middle part hauled back main yard Luffed to on Port Jack Latter part light breeze kept her off steering NW set main gaff clear & pleasant weather Employed in Ship duty
