

Sunday Bk Petrel off Ascension April 16th 1893
This day Breeze with fresh breeze from South steering N.W. at 3 o'clock P.M. Luffed to the wind on Port Jack Island about 5 miles off middle part very light winds latter part the same land in sight

Monday April 17th
This day Breeze with strong breeze from South under all sails cruising off Ascension saw a school of Black fish middle part rain squalls latter part the same

Tuesday April 18th
This day Breeze with squally weather strong winds from South under all. Topsail saw a school of Black fish Island in sight middle part moderate winds latter part strong breeze from South employed in ship duty

Wednesday April 19th
This day Breeze with strong breeze from South under Topsails at night took in upper Topsails Island 10 miles off middle part light breeze latter part strong breeze under Topsails

Thursday April 20th
This day Breeze with fresh breeze from South land in sight rose from main breeze new middle part rain squalls latter part the same under Topsails Island in sight off Seaborn one sail in sight

Friday Bk Petrel off Ascension April 21st 1893
This day Breeze with strong breeze from S.E. steering toward Island at 2 o'clock P.M. came close to the harbor then hauled up on wind heading S.W. Brig Rosa Baker in sight middle part rain squalls latter part blowing quite hard Islands in sight

Saturday April 22nd
This day Breeze with fresh winds from S.E. under lower Topsails Island just out sight middle part the same latter part strong breeze from S.W. steering N.E. by E one sail in sight going north

Sunday April 23rd
This day Breeze with fresh wind from S.E. under all sails at night shortened sail Island in sight 10 miles off middle part rain squalls latter part the same land in sight at 6 o'clock A.M. Kept her off steering N.W. by N under all sails

Monday April 24th
This day Breeze with squally weather light winds from S.E. steering N.W. by N under all sails middle part wind hauled to N.E. latter part the same employed in ship duty

Tuesday April 25th
This day Breeze with light breeze from N.E. steering N.W. by N under all sails Band on main Rayed middle part very light breeze latter part the same employed in repairing main Topgall sail & breaking out water
