

Sunday May 28th 1893

This day Began with very light breeze from NE under all sails at night took in Gaff Tops & fore gallant sail middle part calm latter part the same Employed in setting up main Toppail Back Stays

Monday May 29th

This day Began with very light breeze from SE steering N by E under all sails at night took in light sails middle part the same latter part steering NE under all sails

Tuesday May 30th

This day Began with clear & pleasant weather very light breeze from SE under all sails at night took light sails & three master Schooner in sight going to the westward middle part the same latter part fresh breeze from SE steering N by E under all sails Break out back Stays Let crew have 3 Salons of Pickles

Wednesday May 31st

This day Began with fresh breeze from East steering NE at night took in Light sails & courses hauled back main Yard middle part the same latter part fresh breeze steering NW under all sails Employed in making Fore Stay sail

Thursday June 1st 1893

This day Began with fresh breeze from East at 2 PM spoke Bark George & Mary Capt Costa came on board middle part calm latter part the same at 9 o'clock AM Capt Reed went on board B. K. George & Mary

Friday Bark Pirel at Sea June 2nd 1893

This day Began with very light air from NW under all at 5 o'clock PM Capt Reed return at night took in light sails middle part squally weather latter part the same under all sails

Saturday June 3rd

This day Began with clear weather fresh wind under all sails in company with George & Mary at night shorten sails middle part fresh breeze latter part strong under all sails

Sunday June 4th

This day Began with strong breeze from E heading N by E at night shorten sails middle part the same latter strong breeze clear weather B. K. George & Mary in sight to the windward

Monday June 5th

This day Began with light breeze from East heading NE by N at night shorten sails Began on a new Fore Stay sail middle part squally weather latter part the same Employed in Repairing Fore sail one sail in sight

Tuesday June 6th

This day Began with light breeze from SE steering NW under all sails middle part & latter part very light breeze steering N by N under all sails Manuel de Silva Sick off duty with Sore on his Leg Bored out back Board
