 A.M. reared a Long Spine whale on Lee  
 beam goin South Landed all the Boats  
 Starboard Boat struck the whale at 10  
 o'clock took whale a Long Side  
 Manuel da Silva still Sick off duty

Friday June 9<sup>th</sup>  
 This day Breeze with very light breeze  
 clear & pleasant employed in cutting the  
 whale middle part employed in boiling  
 Latter part finish cutting pleasant weather



Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup>

 breeze employed in stowed down ail

Tuesday June 13<sup>th</sup>  
 This day Breeze with very light breeze  
 from East heading N.E. by N finish stowed  
 ail 93 Barrels middle part calm Latter part  
 the same one sail in sight  
 Manuel da Silva are little better to day  
 Antonio Duarte still Sick give crew 3 Salones  
 rum

Wednesday June 14<sup>th</sup>  
 This day Breeze with dead Calm employed  
 in ship duty middle part very light breeze  
 from S.W. steering East Latter part the same  
 employed in taring down reggen

Thursday June 15<sup>th</sup>  
 This day Breeze with clear & fine weather  
 very light breeze from South heading  
 S by E under all Sails Antonio Duarte are  
 better to day middle part fresh breeze  
 from West Latter part the same  
 steering N.E. under all Sails

Friday June 16<sup>th</sup>  
 This day Breeze with fresh winds and  
 cloudy weather steering S.E. under all  
 Sails at night took in light Sails &  
 luffed to the winds on Starboard  
 tack middle part rain squalls Latter part  
 the same employed in washing ship in  
 side Manuel da Silva are well a little better duty
