

Saturday Bark Petrel June 17th 1893

This day Bigine with rain squalls & winds from West steering S.E. at night luffed to the wind & Shorten Sails middle part the same latter part very much the same

Sunday June 18th

This day Bigine with cloudy weather light breeze from E.S.E. under Topsails at 2 o'clock P.M. spoke a Merchant Bark from Thornaston bound to Bonaeare Captain Reed went on board at night Shorten Sails middle part clear weather latter part the same Break out water

Monday June 19th

This day Bigine with cloudy weather very light breeze from West heading N.W. by N at night Shorten Sails 4 sails been in sight to day middle part squally weather latter part raining very hard & strong breeze

Tuesday June 20th

This day Bigine with fresh winds from N.E. under Lower Topsails heading N.W. middle part strong winds from West heading N.W. by W latter part blowing hard & rain squalls

Wednesday June 21st

This day Bigine with strong winds from West heading N.W. under Lower main Topsail lay to on Port Tack one Topsail Schooner in sight steering about S.W. middle part blowing hard latter part the same steering E by S under Lower Topsails one merchant ship steering to the Eastward

Thursday Bark Petrel June 22nd 1893

This day Bigine with very strong winds steering E by S under Lower Topsails at 5 o'clock P.M. took in Fore Topsail & luffed to the wind on Starboard Tack middle part & latter part blowing very hard & foggy weather

Friday June 23rd

This day Bigine with strong wind from West lay to on Starboard Tack at 5 o'clock P.M. kept her off steering S.E. by S under Lower Topsails middle part luffed to on Starboard Tack heavy Rain squalls

Saturday June 24th

This day Bigine with half gale winds from West heading S.W. by S under Lower main Topsails middle part blowing & very hard latter part squally

Sunday June 25th

This day Bigine with moderate winds from W heading S by W under Lower Topsails one merchant ship in sight steering about S.E. middle part blowing quite strong latter part moderate breeze set Topsail

Monday June 26th

This day Bigine with squally weather strong winds from S.W. took in upper Topsails at night were ship took in Fore Lower Topsail heading S.E. by E middle part blowing quite hard latter part rain squalls were ship heading N.W. under Lower Topsails
