

Tuesday B.K. Petrel June 27th 1893

This day Bigine with squally weather strong winds from SW at night were ship heading S by E under Lower Topsails middle part Blowing quite hard Latter part the same were ship heading N W

Wednesday June 28th

This day Bigine with strong wind from SSW heading NW under Lower Topsails Break out Castles Mallassue middle part rain squalls Latter part the same steering NE set upper Topsails employed in ship duty

Thursday June 29th

This day Bigine with moderate breeze from SSW at 1 o'clock PM luffed to the winds on Part Tack heading NW at night took upper Topsails middle part the same Latter part fresh breeze set light same winds from NW

Friday June 30th

This day Bigine with fresh breeze from West heading S by E at night shorten sails Break out water middle part were ship heading N by W Latter part clear weather fresh breeze under all sails Pump on fore topstay sail & missin staysail gave crew 2 1/2 Salons of Limu Juice

Saturday July 1st

This day Bigine with fresh winds from WSW under all sails at night took in light sails heading N by W middle part strong winds Latter part moderate winds

Sunday B.K. Petrel July 2nd 1893

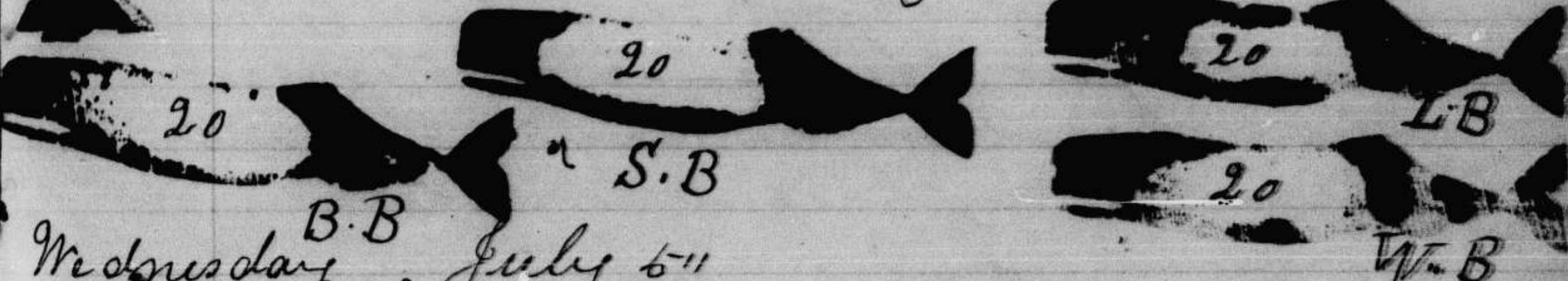
This day Bigine with rain squalls strong breeze from W at Sundown were ship heading S by W took in upper Topsails middle part clear Latter part light breeze under all sails heading South

Monday July 3rd

This day Bigine with fresh breeze from WNW heading N under all sails at night took in light sails middle part light breeze Latter part the same Employed in tarring down Biggen clear weather

Tuesday July 4th

This day Bigine with light breeze from SW under all sails at 4.30 o'clock PM reased alcholes of Sperm whales & Lawred all the Boats & all got fast in Bow Boat got 2 whales at 11 o'clock took whale a long side - middle part employed in getting ready for cutting Latter part Employed in cutt the whale in clear weather Saw one merchant ship goin to the Eastward



Wednesday July 5th

This day Bigine with fresh breeze from SW & pleasant weather finish cutt the in Employed in boiling middle part the same Latter part fine weather at 6 o'clock in morning reased a Large bon Sperm whale goin to the Eastward Lawred Larboard & West Boat West Boat struck at 10 o'clock a m took Whale a long side
