This day Bigone with squally weather Employed in cutting & Boiling middle part clear Latter part the same Employed in cutting & Boiling Antonio de Cruze lentt his rest with Boring knife & he is off duty



Friday July 7th

This day Bigone with fresh breeze from S.W. & clear weather Employed in cutting middle part the same Latter part squally stowed down 40 Barrels of oil & Employed in boiling

Saturday July 8th

This day Bigone with squally weather & strong wind from S.W. Employed in boiling the whale's head still out side Break out back Bread middle part raining Latter part squally took in Whole head & Employed in boiling

Sunday July 9th

This day Bigone with clear weather light breeze from S.W. Employed in boiling middle part the same Latter part Employed in boiling & stowed oil clear & pleasant weather

Monday July 10th

This day Bigone with light breeze from S.W. heading W.N.W. fresh boiling middle part clear & pleasant Latter part the same fresh stowed down oil 189 Barrels all told

Tuesday Bark Petrel at Sea July 11th 1893

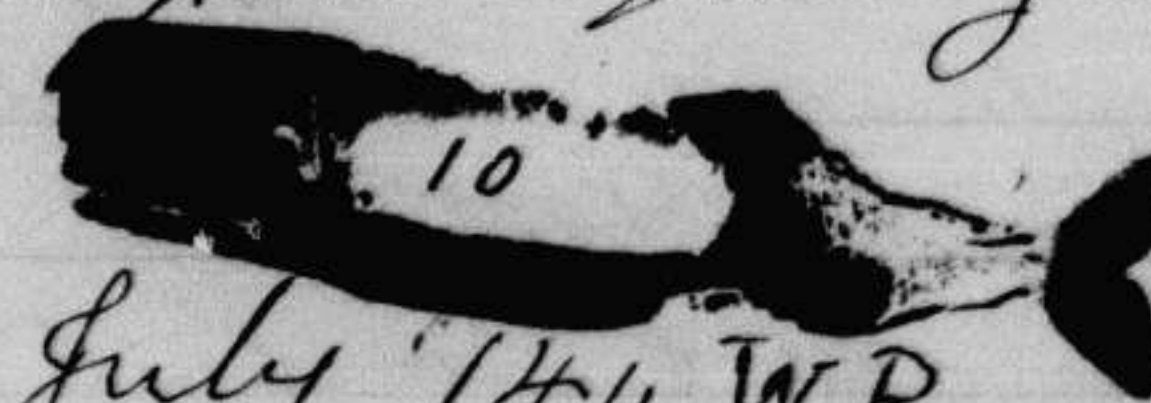
This day Bigone with rainy weather steering E by S under Lower Topsails middle part the same Latter part clear steering S.E. & S. upper Topsails

Wednesday July 12th

This day Bigone with fresh breeze from S.W. steering S.E. at night took in upper Topsails middle part the same Latter part fresh winds South steering W. under all sails at 10.30 o'clock A.M. reased a school of small sperm whales toward Larboard West & Bow Boat Larboard & West Boat struck at 3 o'clock P.M. took whales a long side

Thursday July 13th

This day Bigone with rainy weather Employed in cutting gave a crew 3 gallons of Pickle middle part strong breeze raining Latter part squally Employed in boiling



Friday July 14th W.B.

This day Bigone with strong wind from S.W. under Lower Topsails Employed in boiling middle part blowing quite hard & Rain Latter part squally weather finished Boiling Nicholas Suarez are sick off duty

Saturday July 15th

This day Bigone with squally weather & rough strong winds from S.W. heading S by E middle part blowing quite hard took in Lower Fore Topsail Latter part rain squally Sit main Gallant sail Antonio de Cruze he is getting around but not quite well yet
