

Sunday Bark Petrel at Sea July 16th 1893

This day Bigine with squally weather light breeze from heading S by W middle part calm latter part the same employed in stowed oil Mr Cruise mate hurt his foot bad with back he is off duty at 9.30 o'clock a m rescued school of sperm whales lowered starboard West & Bow Boat West Boat struck Nicholas Suarez ^{will} return to his duty

Monday July 17th

This day Bigine with calm weather at 6.30 o'clock took whale a long side middle part getting ready for cutting very light breeze from West latter part cut whale in very pleasant weather

Tuesday July 18th

This day Bigine with very pleasant weather finish cutting employed in boiling middle part fine weather latter part finish boiling blandy weather Mr Cruise dont feel much better

Wednesday July 19th

This day Bigine with rainy weather fresh winds from S by W middle part light fog & rain latter part light fog & light breeze employed in stowed down oil

Thursday July 20

This day Bigine with light breeze from S by W middle part squally weather latter part hard rain squalls wind from W by W gave crew 3 Gallons of Lime Juice & 3 Gallons of Pickle

Friday Bark Petrel July 21 1893

This day Bigine with rainy weather fresh breeze from S W under Lower Tapsails heading S by E Antonio Da Cruz are well and return to his duty again middle part squally latter part blandy weather light breeze under all sails wind from W by W heading North Mr Cruise feel little better to day

Saturday July 22nd

This day Bigine with light breeze from S W under all sails blandy weather at Sundown Tack Ship heading South & Shorten Sails Saw one steamer going Westward middle part took in upper Tapsails strong breeze & raining quite hard latter part squally heading W by W

Sunday July 23rd

This day Bigine with very strong wind from S W under Lower Tapsails at night took in Fore Tapsail wave ship on Starboard Tack heading S by E middle part blowing very hard & rain squalls latter part the same Mr Cruise feel quite well to day

Monday July 24th

This day Bigine with strong Gale wind from S W & heavy rain squalls Laying to on Starboard Tack heading South middle part raining hard & moderate wind latter the same set upper Tapsails
