

Tuesday Bark Petrel at Sea July 25th 1893
 This day Breeze with moderate winds from S.W. heavy rain under topsails. Saw one Steamer going to the Westward Middle part the same. Latter part Clear & pleasant weather under all sail steering W by N wind from E.S.E.

Wednesday July 26th

This day Breeze with clear & pleasant weather fresh breeze from E.W. steering West by N at night Shorten sail middle part hauled back main yard. Latter part fresh breeze from E.S.E. under all sail employed in washing the masts.

Thursday July 27th

This day Breeze with fresh breeze from E.S.E. under all sail steering W by N Bind on main Rayail. Saw one Steamer going Eastward Middle part wind from W.W. Latter part the same. Employed in washing a ship in side. Saw one merchant ship going to the Eastward. Mrs. Cruise foot getting long nicely.

Friday July 28th

This day Breeze with fresh wind from W.S.W. under all sail. Employed in washing a ship in side. Saw one merchant ship going Southward. Middle part light breeze from North heading W.W. under all sail. Latter part the same. Employed in ship's duty.

Saturday Bark Petrel July 29th 1893

This day Breeze with very light breeze from East steering W.W. under all sails. Middle part very light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze. Cloudy weather. Saw one merchant ship going Eastward gave crew & Salome vinegar.

Sunday July 30th

This day Breeze with fresh breeze from S.W. steering W.W. under all sails. Middle part very Cloudy weather fresh breeze. Latter part Squally weather. Strong wind took in Gallant sail.

Monday July 31st

This day Breeze with Squally weather. Strong wind from W.S.W. heading S.W. under topsails. Middle part heavy rain. Squally. Latter part the same took in upper topsails.

Tuesday Aug 1st 1893

This day Breeze with strong wind from W.S.W. under lower topsails & heavy squally weather. Lying to on Port Jack. Middle part blowing. Very hard took in fore topsail. Latter part the same.

Wednesday Aug 2nd

This day Breeze with moderate winds from W heading S by W. Set lower topsails & courses. Saw a school of Black fish. Middle part rain. Squally. Latter part calm. Employed in painting ship in side. Saw one Steamer going to the Eastward.
