West Middle & Sutterparts light breeze & pleasant at day
light saw Chatham island bearing West Distance 20 miles
Van Whale Bark in sight

May 15th 1856 Remarks on Board Saturday the 16th
These 24 hours light air at 2 p.m. spoked the Joshua
Brayden of New Bedford 32 months caught 1000 spearm
Middle & Sutterparts light breeze from SE pleasant too
sails in sight hoodes island bearing SW Distance 15 miles

May 15th 1856 Remarks on Board Sunday the 17th
These 24 hours light breeze from SE pleasant at 3 p.m.
Tacked too SE and Distance 15 miles Middle & Sutterparts
The same saw black fish hoodes island bearing SW
Distance 10 miles

May 15th 1856 Remarks on Board Monday the 18th
These 24 hours light breeze from SE at 2 p.m. sent
A boat in too hoodes island & caught a Mops of
fish at 6 came on Board Middle & Sutterparts As a dove
Comptered SW
