 Satterparts At 12.4 M took a strong S & took in
 flying gibs & fore to go gallant sail

Remarks on Board Monday May the 28th 1860
 These 24 Hours strong S & Wind At 1 p.m. the pilot
 left coarsteard West Employed securing
 Boats & Anchors Middle & Satterparts fresh
 Breezes from S & pleasant At 4.4 M set the studding sails
 Coarsteard W by S Lat 21° 15' N

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 29 1860
 These 24 Hours light Breezes & huffling attended
 With showers of rain, coarsteard W by S to sales
 in sight Steering the same Middle & Satterparts
 Light Breezes & pleasant coarsteard W by S
 Lat 21° 00' N

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 30 1860
 These 24 Hours fresh Breezes from S & pleasant
 Weather coarsteard W by S Employed at ships Duty
 to sales in sight Middle & Satterparts as a bore
 Coarsteard W by S to sales in sight at 6.4 M saw
 the land Distance 5 miles Lat 21° 30' N
 Long 84° 10' W

Remarks on Board Thursday May 31 1860
 These 24 Hours light Breezes from East mostly
 Weather coarsteard W by S & sales in sight
 Middle & Satterparts light Breezes from E & S
 pleasant Weather coarsteard W by S & sales in
 sight land Distance 5 miles Lat 21° 50' N
 Long 84° 10' W
