Pleasant Weather Comptered S & E & ship's steering
the same Middle & Latter parts strong Breezes
Halling to the S & W Comptered S
Lat 27° 23' N
Long 74° 36' W

Remarks on Board Saturday June the 9th 1860
These 24 Hours light Wind & a heavy swell from
N & W at 2 p.m. shifted to the S & E Comptered North
Middle & Latter parts strong Breezes & squall halled to
W & S Comptered North at 4 A.M. took in the light
sails Lat 30° 23' N
Long 74° 43' W

Remarks on Board Sunday June the 10th 1860
These 24 Hours strong Breezes from N & W misty
Weather Comptered N & E Middle & Latter parts strong
Breezes at 10 A.M. shifted to S & W squally heading S & E
Lat 31° 30' N
Long 74° 48' W

Remarks on Board Monday June the 11th 1860
These 24 Hours strong Breezes from N & W & Boffling
heading S by E Middle & Latter parts light air & calm
At 4 A.M. light Breezes from S & W Comptered S & E
At 10 halled to S & W heading S & E
Lat 32° 12' N
Long 76° 34' W

These 24 Hours as a Bore Middle & Latter parts
At 1 A.M. halled to East Comptered S & E
Lat 33° 12' N
Long 75° 46' W
