This day commences with strong breezes from East South East
the middle part equally took in the main top gallant
jail and spanken the latter part of the day strong breezes
from South East John Reed off duty sick. the Watch Employed
in Ship Duty Lat 5=08 Longi 24=38 West

Wednesday 27

This day commences with strong breezes and squally
and rain the middle part strong winds from East South East
and clear the latter part the same at 11 AM set the
fore topmast jarring jail John Reed off duty the Watch
Employed in Ship Duty Lat 7=24 Longi 25=32 West

Thursday 28

This day commences with strong breezes from South East
and clear at 11 AM took in the fore top gallant jail.
the middle part strong winds and clear at 3 AM burst
the yard the latter part more moderate this day John Reed
came on duty the Watch Employed in Ship Duty Lat 9=50 Longi 26=42 West

This day strong trades and clear the winds from South East

part the same at 10 AM set the fore top gallant jail strong winds from East
and clear Joseph Antonio Jernan sick. this day got out one cask
of oil and killed a pig. the Watch Employed in Ship Duty
Lat 14=20 Longi 28=17 West

This day commences with light winds from North at 4 PM set the
main top gallant jail and all the jarring jails at 4 PM
equally the middle part of the day light winds and clear the
latter part light winds and clear this day Joseph Antonio came
to duty. the Watch Employed in Ship Duty Lat 17=11 Longi 30=17

Tuesday 2

This day commences with light winds and squally rain this
day bent the spanken middle part fresh breezes and clear
the winds South East by East the latter part equally with light
rain. the Watch Employed in Ship Duty Lat 18=58 Longi 30=54 West

Wednesday 3

This day commences with fresh breezes from East South East
at 4 PM unbent the fore jail and fore topmast jarring
and bent the spanken the middle part strong breezes and clear
the latter part more moderate the Watch Employed in Ship Duty
Lat 20=36 Longi 32=00

Thursday 4

This day commences with light winds from East at 4 PM
the main main top sail and main stay jail at 3 PM set the lower
jarring jail and the main top gallant do at 5 PM set a jail stann
into the South the middle part of this day fresh breezes and
clear the latter part moderate and clear the Watch Employed in
Ship Duty Lat 22=04 Longi 33=04

Friday 5

this day got up water from the kegs round the Cape. the Watch
