February

Thursday 5

This day commences with strong winds from West with Rain at 1 P.M. fastened the Main top sail at the same time gave a furler upon her to see the Venetian plates clearing to the North East at 2 P.M. Double reefed the Main top sail below the gill and then at 2 P.M. hoist reefed the top sails and reefed the fore sail the wind at N.W. with plenty of Rain at 11 at noon furl the Main sail Lat 57-143 Long 65-24

Friday 6

This day commences with strong winds from West attended with Rain at 2 P.M. furl the fore and Main top sails at 4 P.M. more Moder at 4 P.M. fore and Main top sail at 7 P.M. get the Main sail the Middle part of the day Moderate but covered out the top sails but the fore and Main top sails. Latter part strong winds from West attended with Rain at 11 at noon reef the top sails took in the gill and Main top sail Lat 58-54 Long 69-55

Saturday 10

This day commences with strong winds at 4 P.M. hoist reefed the fore top sail and reefed the fore sail. at 10 P.M. cast one reef out the top sails at midnight gave a Whirl ship steering south West at 4 P.M. furl the Main sail and hoist reefed the top sails. at 6 P.M. get the Main sail cast one reef out the Main top sail at 10 P.M. furl the Main sail hoist reefed the Main top sail all the day Rainy and foggy the Wind from West to South Lat 58-32 Long 70-45

Sunday 11

This day commences with strong winds from West at 3 P.M. furl the fore and Main top sail. at 4 P.M. get the Main top sail and give Down at 9 P.M. furl the Main top sail at the same time took in the fore top Mast top sail at 11 P.M. gave a ship steering West. Lat 58-56 Long 70-18

Monday 12

This day commences with heavy gales from West attended with White Rain and snow at 10 P.M. get the Main top sail hoist reefed at 11 P.M. took it in again at 2 P.M. get the Main top sail hoist reefed at 4 P.M. get the fore sail reefed at 5 P.M. get the fore and Main top sails at 10 at noon hoist reefed the top sails get the Main sail Lat 58-46 Long 70-04

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Tuesday 13

This day commences with light winds from West at 2 P.M. get all sail at 2 P.M. took in the Main top sail at 4 P.M. Double reefed the top sails at hoist reefed the top sail reefed the fore sail at 8 P.M. furl the Main sail. Lat 58-50 Long 72-23

Wednesday 14

This day commences with strong winds from North West at 1 P.M. get the Main sails at 6 P.M. furl the Main sail the Middle part Wind and Rainy at 3 P.M. took in the fore and Main top sails and fore sail at 5 P.M. get the fore sail at 8 P.M. get the fore and Main top sails at 10 P.M. get the Main sail Lat 59-13 Long 72-45

Thursday 15

This day commences with strong winds from North West attended with rain and heavy fogs at 4 P.M. furl the Main sail at 3 P.M. took in the fore and Main top sail furl the fore sail hoist under hoist reefed Main top sail and Main sail at 10 more moderate get the fore sail 12 at noon get the fore and Main top sail the at West Lat 59-44 Long 73-45

Friday 16

This day commences with strong winds from North attended with Rain at 1 P.M. get the Main sail at 4 P.M. get the gill at 5 P.M. get the Main top sail at 6 P.M. get the fore and Main top sail at 7 P.M. the Wind changed from a West to South West at 9 P.M. took in the gill and Main top sail hoist reefed the Main top sail at 10 P.M. furl the fore and Main top sail at 11 P.M. hoist all hands furl the fore sail Main top sail fore top hoist reefed Main top sail hoist the ship to under 3 Main sails at 8 P.M. reefed the Main top sail. Lat 58-50 Long 73-52

Saturday 17

This day commences with heavy gales from North Middle part more Moderate at 2 P.M. get the Main top sail and fore sail at 4 P.M. get the fore and Main top sail hoist reefed at 9 P.M. get the Main sail gill and Main top sail Lat 58-00 Long 74-54

Sunday 18

This day commences with strong winds from South West at 1 P.M. gave a ship to the South West the Wind at West with White the Middle part
